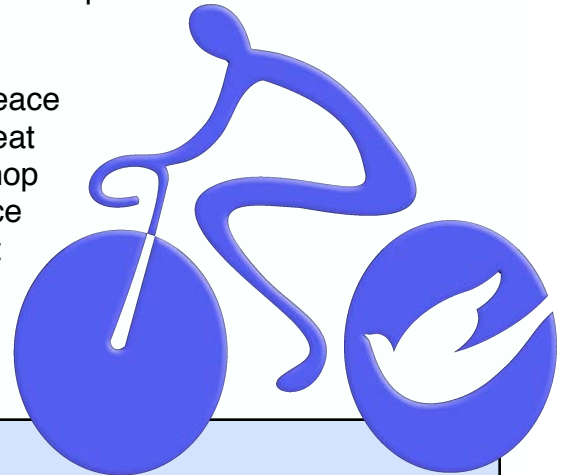


Support non-profits by supporting the Colorado Peace Ride!
